

Thank you for your interest in becoming a volunteer at Project Acorn! Volunteer Adult Leaders serve a special role at Project Acorn. Acting as a resource for Youth Leaders and participants, Adult Leaders help to enhance the Project Acorn experience and to open up spaces for informal discussion and role-modeling.

To participate in Project Acorn as an Adult Leader, you must be at least 25 years of age. It is also preferred that you have previously been involved with youth mentoring or leadership development in some capacity. All volunteers will be screened, selected, oriented, assigned and supported by the Project Coordinator and Executive Director according to the needs of the program and in the best interests of our participants and Youth Leaders. Given the nature of the role of our Adult Leaders, we ask that you are available to attend all of Project Acorn, and commit to being present in its entirety, including an orientation before the program, and a debrief and clean-up afterwards.

All Adult Leaders are required to complete media, medical and volunteer agreement forms, as well as a criminal reference check, prior to attending Project Acorn. These forms will be sent to you, along with a copy of the Project Acorn Policies and Procedures once your participation has been confirmed.
